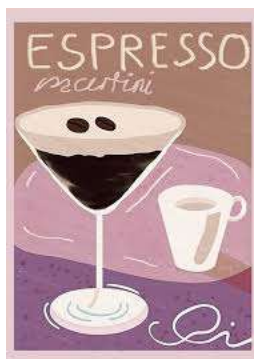

About the grapes...

Moscato: Moscato is a style of wine made from muscat grapes. It's famous for sweet flavours of peaches and orange blossom and because it's lower in alcohol than other sparkling wines.

Pinot Grigio: generally known for its light-bodied, crisp, and refreshing profile. Common tasting notes include green apple, pear, citrus.

Grillo: known for its aromatic complexity and bright acidity, offering a range of flavors from citrus and floral notes to tropical fruit and savory hints.

Sauvignon Blanc: dry, white wine known for its bold, aromatic flavors and high acidity. Common tasting notes include citrus, green fruits, and herbaceous notes like grass or bell pepper.

Catarratto: known for its fresh, fruity, and often savory character, offering a range of flavors from citrus and green apple to tropical fruits and hints of almond and honey.

Chardonnay: tasting notes often include a range of fruit flavors, from citrus to stone fruits and even tropical notes like pineapple, depending on the climate and winemaking techniques.

Arneis: known for their aromatic, dry, and medium-bodied profile, often exhibiting floral notes, pear, citrus, and apricot flavors.

Vermentino: typically light to medium-bodied, with vibrant acidity and a range of citrus and stone fruit flavors. Common tasting notes include lime, green apple, white florals, and a characteristic saline or sea spray note.

Riesling: known for their vibrant acidity, aromatic intensity, and diverse flavor profiles that range from zesty citrus and green apple to richer notes of honey and stone fruit.

Garganega: typically offers a dry, refreshing, and aromatic experience. It often displays delicate floral and citrus aromas, along with flavors of pear, apricot, and almond

About the grapes...

Lambrusco: a refreshing experience with vibrant acidity and fruity notes, often featuring red and dark berries like cherry, strawberry, and blackberry.

Pinot Noir: light body, known for its red fruit aromas, earthy notes, and bright acidity.

Nebbiolo: known for their complex aromas, high acidity, and firm tannins, offering a unique tasting experience. They often display red fruit flavors like cherry and raspberry, accompanied by floral notes of rose and violet, and earthy undertones of tar, leather, and sometimes truffle.

Nerello Mascalese: known for their aromatic complexity and structure, often exhibiting bright red fruit notes like cherry and cranberry, alongside earthy, mineral, and sometimes spicy or floral characteristics.

Grenache: typically offers a fruity and spicy profile with notes of red berries, especially raspberry and strawberry, alongside hints of white pepper and cinnamon.

Barbera: known for its high acidity, low tannins, and vibrant red fruit flavors, often featuring notes of cherries, raspberries, and blackberries. It's generally described as medium-bodied

Sangiovese: vibrant Italian red wine grape, is known for its sour red cherry, dried herb, and earthy notes. It typically exhibits high acidity and medium-plus tannins, often with a savory character and a long finish.

Montepulciano: known for their dark fruit flavors, earthy notes, and moderate tannins, offering a rich and full-bodied experience. Common tasting notes include black cherry, plum, blackberry, and boysenberry.

Gaglioppo: a red Italian wine grape primarily grown in Calabria, is known for its intense red color, high acidity, and firm tannins. It often exhibits flavors of sour red cherry, pomegranate, and rhubarb, with notes of orange peel and white pepper.

Nero d'Avola: Sicily's signature red wine, is known for its bold, dark fruit flavors, often described as black cherry and plum, with hints of black pepper, licorice, and sometimes even dark chocolate or espresso.

Tempranillo: medium to full body, known for its flavors of red and black fruits like cherry, plum, and blackberry, along with notes of tobacco, leather, and vanilla, particularly when aged in oak.

Negroamaro: typically offers a bold and expressive taste with notes of dark fruits like black cherry, plum, and blackberry. It often features herbal and earthy undertones, sometimes with hints of spice, tobacco, and licorice. The wine is generally medium to full-bodied with medium-high tannins and acidity.

Cabernet Sauvignon: full-bodied red wine known for its bold flavors and ability to age well. It typically exhibits notes of dark fruits like blackcurrant, blackberry, and plum, often with hints of spice, cedar, and tobacco due to oak aging.

Shiraz: also known as Syrah, is a full-bodied red wine with a diverse range of tasting notes, often described as bold and fruity. Common flavors include blackberry, plum, and black cherry, with spicy notes of black pepper, licorice, and sometimes hints of tobacco or smoked meat.

Primitivo: known for their bold, fruit-forward flavors and full-bodied character. Common tasting notes include ripe red and black fruits like cherry, blackberry, and raspberry, often with spicy notes of black pepper and cinnamon.

Malbec: full-bodied with rich, dark fruit flavors and spice notes. It's known for its smooth tannins and can range from intensely fruity to more savory expressions depending on the region. Argentinian Malbec, in particular, is celebrated for its dark fruit profile, often with hints of chocolate and vanilla.
